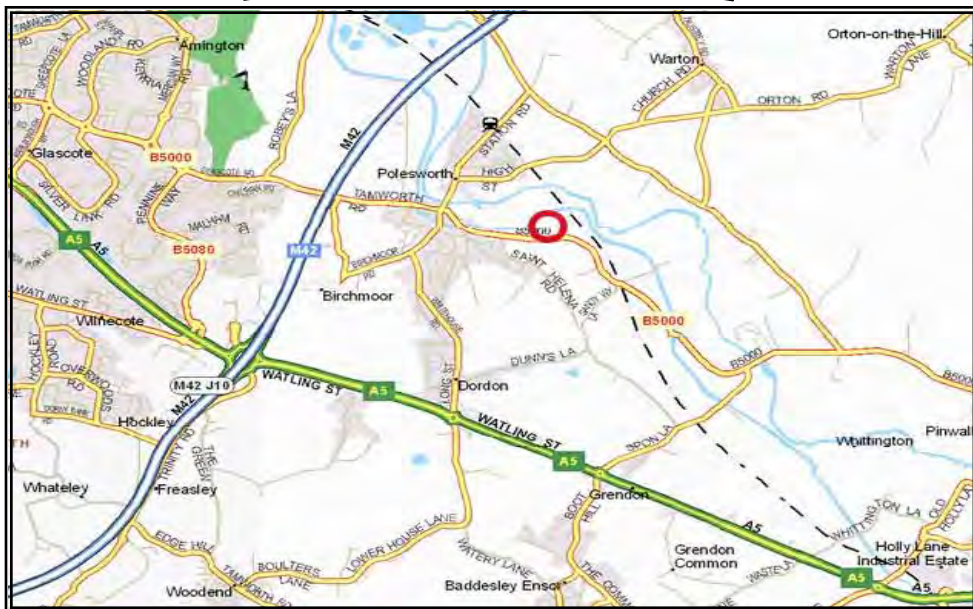



Hartshill Riding Club Rules 2009



General

1. Riders are to receive their rosettes mounted in the relevant ring at the end of the class (except Dressage). Failure will result in no annual points being allocated to them and disqualification.
2. All day trophies must be signed for. These must be returned to the caravan before the start of the class at the next show. Failure to do so will result in the loss of 8 points. These trophies must be returned in a clean, good state of repair.
3. Canter/Galloping is prohibited outside of any defined competition/warm-up ring.
4. Owners entering horses/ponies do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind shall be attached to the organisers of Hartshill Riding Club.
5. Hats conforming to the appropriate British safety standards and correct footwear must be worn at all times when mounted by ALL riders and must be Securely fastened.
6. No rider over the age of 15 on 01/01/09 to ride 12.2 ponies on the field.
7. No rider under the age of 14 on 01/01/09 will be allowed to wear spurs.
8. No practising is allowed in ANY of the rings before the class starts.
9. All competitors are expected to have the horse they are riding, insured for themselves and 3rd party.
10. Members must have entered a class at least 3 times to be eligible for annual points and the end of year trophy for that class.
11. Objections to be submitted to a committee member in writing, within 30 minutes of the event, with a deposit of £10.00. If the objection is not sustained, such deposit will be forfeited.
12. Horses or Ponies must not be left unattended when tied to horse boxes or trailers.
13. The judges decision is final.
14. All riders riding on the showground do so at their own risk.
15. All vehicles are parked at owners' risk.
16. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the schedule without prior notice and refuse any entry.
17. There will be a £1 charge per rider per show day towards first aid.
18. For those classes that carry annual points, these are awarded as follows
 - 4 points for 1st place
 - 3 points for 2nd place
 - 2 points for 3rd place
 - 1 point for 4th place
19. Any breach of the rules may result in the loss of points for the day.

Lead Rein

1. Children may ride unaccompanied on the field AT THE PARENTS OWN DISCRETION.
2. Lead Rein Children must not jump in any of the jumping classes off the lead rein.
3. Lead Rein must not be attached to the bit.
4. All Lead Rein ponies must be 13.2 or under.

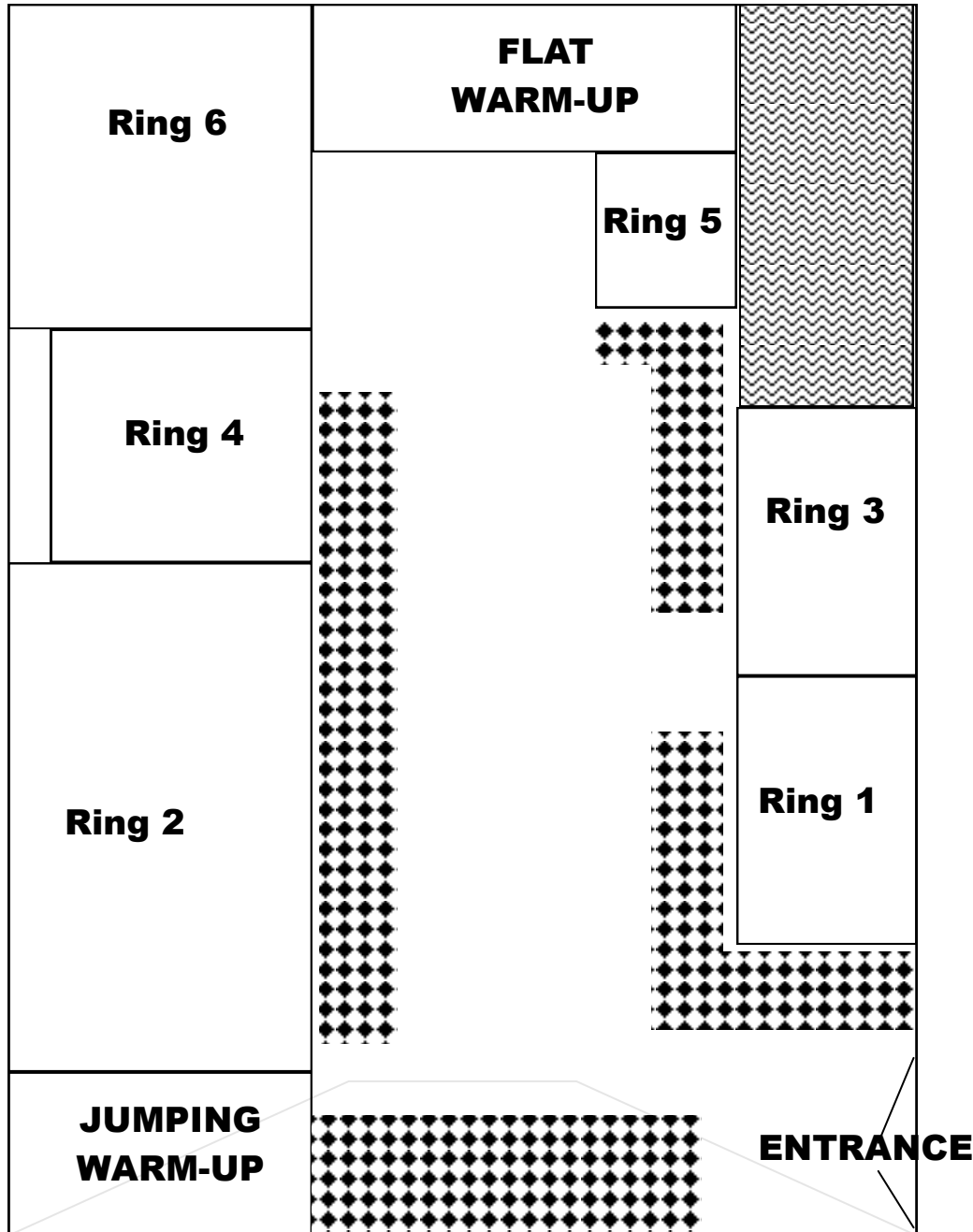

Class 1 In Hand

It is the Pony/Horse that is being judged, however a skilled handler can do much to exhibit the animal to show off its best qualities.

Scoring : Manners 20%, Conformation 60%, Overall Presentation 20%

The In Hand class is split into Juniors and Seniors with rosettes awarded separately

♦ Class 2 Best Turned Out

Ridden. Pony/horse must be correctly and immaculately presented to the Judge.

Scoring : Overall view 40%, Pony/Horse 30 %, Rider 30%

♦ Class 3 Mountain and Moorland

Ridden. Open to all Native Breeds

Scoring : Correctness of Breed Type and Conformation 60%, Manners 20%, Overall Presentation 20%

♦ Class 4 Best Rider

Ridden. Scoring : Position of Rider 20%, Correctness & Effectiveness of Aids 20%, Individual Show 30%, Overall Presentation 30%

♦ Class 5 Riding Pony /Horse

Ridden. Scoring : Suitability 30%, Performance & Manners 30%, Conformation 20%, Overall Presentation 20%

♦ Each class is split into Lead Rein, Juniors and Seniors with rosettes awarded separately.

In class 4 an award will be made to the Junior Best Rider in the First Ridden section.

Showing Specific Rules and Regulations

1. Lead rein must not have reached their 8th birthday by 1st January 2009.
2. Juniors must not have reached their 16th birthday by 1st January 2009.
3. Seniors must be 16 years of age or over on the 1st January 2009.
4. Judges decision is final

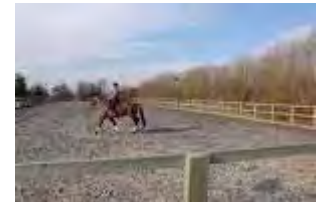

Gymkhana specific Rules and Regulations

- 1.Arms must be covered in Gymkhana.
- 2.No whips, spurs or use of the rope as a whip allowed in Gymkhana.
- 3.The pony and runner must be nominated for the day and to last all day.
- 4.Lead rein in A,B or C group must be non-competitive.
- 5.If there are insufficient numbers, the judge has the right to merge classes.
- 6.The Judge's decision is final.
- 7.The above are in addition to the General Rules and regulations of Hartshill Riding Club.

Single Phase : All classes apart from the clear round will be single phase. Competitors will jump the whole course and will be timed over the second section.

All the above classes horses and ponies may jump together, but will be judged and rosettes given separately. When entering you MUST declare if you are jumping a pony or horse.

Ponies 14.2 and under, Horses over 14.2

*These classes are for genuine Novice horse and riders. We ask all riders to enter these classes accordingly.

Show Jumping specific Rules and Regulations

- 1.Show/Hacking jackets must be worn in all jumping events unless specified by the judge.
- 2.Studs, spurs and whips will be allowed in the main jumping ring but excessive use may lead to disqualification.
- 3.Practice jumps, these must be jumped with the red flag on the RIGHT HAND SIDE.
- 4.The height of the practice jump must not exceed the height of the fences of the current show-jumping class.
- 5.All entries for the jumping classes are to be made BEFORE the start of the class, exception is the clear round where entries will close at 10.30am, or where the appropriate late entry fees have been paid.
- 6.Any competitor who takes a fall will be eliminated and asked to leave the ring dismounted.
- 7.If you are eliminated you may jump a SINGLE fence before leaving the ring.
- 8.The height of the main ring jumping will not exceed stated height on programme.
- 9.The course builders have the final say in height due to weather restrictions on the day.
- 10.Any horse/rider combination winning or being placed 2nd in a 2'6" jumping class or higher more than twice (4 competitors or more), will not be eligible to take part competitively in the 2' - class 2.
- 11.Any horse/rider combination winning or being placed 2nd in a 2'9" jumping class or higher more than twice(4 competitors or more), will not be eligible to take part competitively in the 2'3" - class 3.
- 12.Classes 2, 3, 4 & 5 are not open to BSJA Registered horses/ponies.

Dressage Specific Rules and Regulations

1. Junior or Restricted is a combination of horse & rider not to have been placed 1st three or more times (applies to Juniors effective from 2009 only - not retrospectively).
2. Junior Open or Senior Open is a combination of horse and rider that holds any British Eventing or British Dressage points or have been placed 1st three or more times at Hartshill Riding Club in that class (ie WT, Prelim, Novice).
3. No refunds after closing date.
4. It is the competitor's responsibility to be ready and to present themselves to the dressage steward at the entrance to the arena at least ten minutes before their allocated time. Failure to present in good time may result in the withdrawal of a competitor without refund of fees.
5. The Walk Trot test is for genuine novices only and is not open to entrants of our BD Novice class unless the entry is non-competitive.
