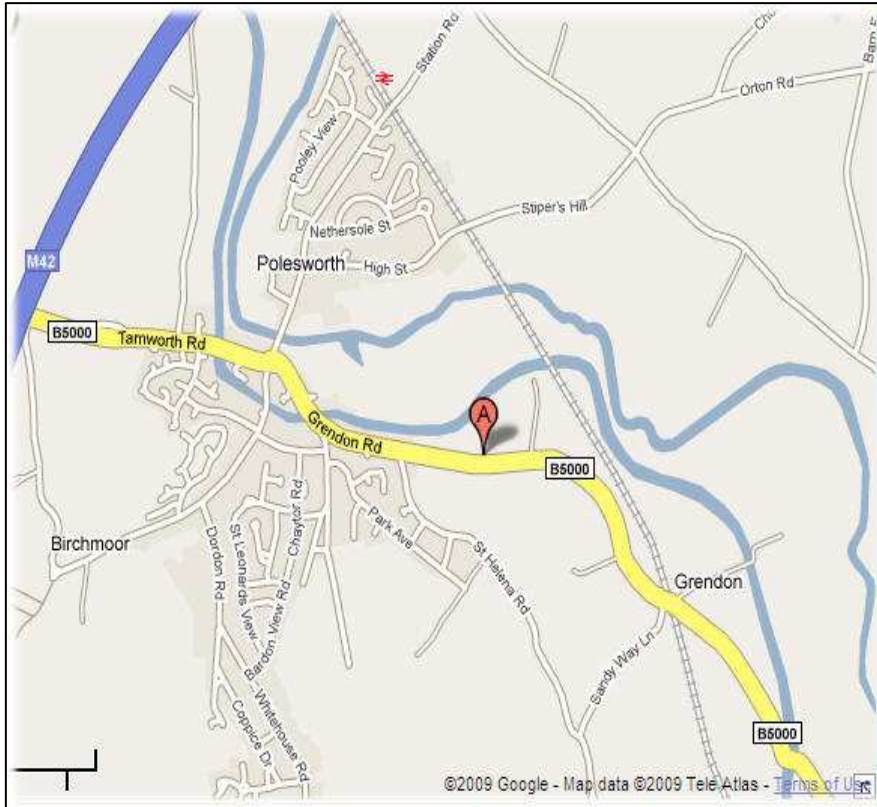

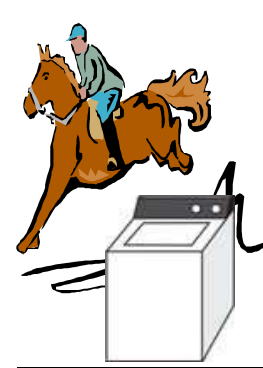

Dressage Rules

The Judge's decision is final.

Please ensure that you are at the collecting ring 10 mins before your allocated time and declare your intention to ride the test to the dressage steward. Failure to present in good time may result in the withdrawal of a competitor without the refund of fees. The show MUST run to time to ensure that we are fair to everyone.

- **All classes are split Junior, Senior, restricted and open.**
- **Restricted** is a combination of horse & rider not to have been placed 1st three times or more in a class of 3 or more competitors at Hartshill Riding Club.
- **Open** is a horse that holds any British Dressage or British Eventing points or a combination of horse and rider that has been placed 1st three or more times at Hartshill Riding Club in that class (ie WT, Prelim, Novice).

HRC beginner Tests (available to download from HRC website)

These tests are designed for the ABSOLUTE BEGINNER. This can mean absolute beginner as in you, the horse, or the combination. It is totally acceptable for you to ride a walk trot test on a "green horse" even if you have previously ridden Preliminary tests at a good standard on a different horse.

HRC Preliminary Tests

These tests are for those moving up from the walk trot tests. Some of these tests are easier than others and we try to alter the level of difficulty from show to show. All tests can be purchased from the British Dressage (BD) website.

Ring One

Show Jumping Classes:

Class 1 55cm (1ft 9") Clear Round
Starting at 9.30am (entries close 10.30am)
Entrance fee : £3.00
Rosettes to all clear rounds

Starting at 11am
Entrance fee : £4.50
Rosettes to 4th place

These classes are for genuine Novice horses and riders. We ask all riders to enter these classes accordingly

Class 2 60cm (2ft) (see Rule 11 for further information)

Class 3 70cm (2ft 3) (see Rule 12 for further information)

Not before 12.30pm

Class 4 75cm (2ft 6)

Class 5 85cm (2ft 9)

Not before 2.00pm

Class 6 90cm (3ft)

Class 7 100cm (3ft 3)

Additional height classes will be held if time permits.

Entries for the above classes close 5 minutes after the start of that class, after which time entry will be subject to a £1 late entry fee.

Single Phase : All classes apart from the clear round will be single phase. Competitors will jump the whole course and will be timed over the second section.

Horses and ponies will jump the same course but will be judged and rosettes given separately. When entering you MUST declare if you are jumping a horse or a pony.

Ponies 14.2 (148cm) and under. Horses over 14.2 (148cm)

Show Jumping specific Rules and Regulations

1. Show/Hacking jackets must be worn in all jumping events unless specified by the judge.
2. Studs, spurs and whips will be allowed in the main jumping ring but excessive use may lead to Disqualification.
3. Riders under 14 may not wear spurs.
4. Practice jumps, these must be jumped with the red flag on the RIGHT hand side.
5. The height of the practice jump must not exceed the height of the fences in the current show jumping class.
6. All entries for the jumping classes are to be made BEFORE the start of the class, exception is the clear round where entries will close at 10.30am, or where the appropriate late entry fees have been paid.
7. Any competitor who takes a fall will be eliminated and asked to leave the ring dismounted.
8. If you are eliminated for any other reason you may jump a SINGLE fence before leaving the ring.
9. The height of the fences in the main ring will not exceed stated height in the programme.
10. The course builders/judge will have the final say in height due to weather conditions on the day.
11. Any horse/rider combination winning or being placed 2nd in a 75cm (2'6) jumping class or higher more than twice (4 competitors or more), will not be eligible to take part competitively in the 60cm (2') - class 2.
12. Any horse/rider combination winning or being placed 2nd in a 85cm (2'9) jumping class or higher more than twice (4 competitors or more), will not be eligible to take part competitively in the 70cm (2' 3) class 3

Hartshill Riding Club Rules 2011 continued

13. For those classes that carry annual point, these are awarded as follows

- 4 points for 1st place
- 3 points for 2nd place
- 2 points for 3rd place
- 1 point for 4th place

14. Any breach of the rules may result in the loss of points for the day.

15. Horses and ponies must not be left unattended when tied to horse boxes or trailers.

16. Objections to be submitted to a committee member in writing, within 30 minutes of the event, with a deposit of £10. If the objection is not sustained, such deposit will be forfeited.

17. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the schedule without prior notice and refuse any entry.

The judges decision is final.

Lead Rein

1. All lead rein ponies must be 13.2hh or under
2. Lead rein must not be attached to the bit
3. Lead rein children must not jump in any of the jumping classes off the lead rein

Lead rein children may ride unaccompanied on the showground AT THE PARENTS OWN DISCRETION

Ring Two **Mini Show Jumping**

Starting at 12.00pm

Entrance fee : £3.00 per class

Rosettes to 4th place

Class 1 40cm (1ft 3) Lead Rein

Class 2 45cm (1ft 6) Mini Jumping

Class 3 55cm (1ft 9) Open Mini Jumping

Competitors are reminded, that entering the mini jumping excludes entry into any class in the main show jumping ring on the same horse/pony on the same show day with the exception of the clear round (Class 1)

Ring Three

Showing Commences at 10am

Entrance Fee : £3.50 per class

Class 1 In Hand

It is the horse/pony that is being judged, however a skilled handler can do much to exhibit the animal to show off it's best qualities.

Scoring: Manners 20% Conformation 60% Overall Presentation 20%

The In Hand class is split into Juniors and Seniors with rosettes awarded separately.

Class 2 Best Turned Out

Ridden Horse/Pony must be correctly and immaculately presented to the judge.

Scoring: Overall view 40% Horse/Pony 30% Rider 30%

Class 3 Mountain and Moorland

Ridden. Open to all Native breeds

Scoring : Correctness of breed type and conformation 60% Manners 20%

Overall presentation 20%

Class 4 Best Rider

Ridden

Scoring : Position of Rider 20% Correctness and effectiveness of aids

20% Individual show 30% Overall presentation 30%

Class 5 Riding Club Horse/Pony

Ridden

Scoring Suitability 30% Performance and manners 30% Conformation

20% Overall presentation 20%

Each class is split into Lead Rein, Juniors and Seniors with rosettes awarded separately.

In Class 4 an award will be made to the Junior Best Rider in the First Ridden section

Hartshill Riding Club Rules 2011

General

1. Riders are to receive their rosettes mounted in the relevant ring at the end of the class (except Dressage). Failure will result in no annual points being allocated to them and disqualification.
2. Canter/Galloping is prohibited outside of any defined competition/warm-up ring.
3. All riders riding on the showground do so at their own risk.
4. All vehicles are parked at owners' risk.
5. Owners entering horses/ponies do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind shall be attached to the organisers of Hartshill Riding Club.
6. Hats conforming to the appropriate British safety standards and correct footwear must be worn at all times when mounted by ALL riders and must be securely fastened.
7. All riders should be the appropriate weight for their mount.
8. There will be a £1 charge per rider per show day towards first aid.
9. No practising is allowed in ANY of the rings before the class starts.
10. All competitors are expected to have the horse they are riding, insured for themselves and 3rd party.
11. Members must have entered a class at least 3 times to be eligible for annual points and the end of year trophy for that class.

Showing Specific Rules and Regulations

1. Lead rein competitors must not have reached their 8th birthday on 1st January 2011.
2. Junior competitors must not have reached their 16th birthday on 1st January 2011
3. Senior competitors must be 16 years of age or over on 1st January 2011
4. The judges decision is final

ROYAL LONDON 2011 and MIDARC 2011 QUALIFIERS

Class 1: Show Hunter Pony. Not exceeding 153cms. Qualifier cards will be split into n/e 122cm, exc 122cm n/e 133cm, exc 133 n/e 143 and exc 134cm n/e 153cm.

Class 2: Riding Horse. Open to horses over 15hns, qualifier cards will be spilt into small and large.

Class 3: Ridden Cob. Qualifier cards will be spilt into lightweight and heavyweight.

Class 4: Ridden Coloured horse/pony. Qualifier cards will be spilt into Piebald/ Skewbald and Palomino/ Dun/ Cream/ Roan.

Class 5: Ridden Veteran. Open to horses/ponies over the age of 15 years old. Qualifier cards will be spilt into not exc 148 cm and over 148 cm

Class 6: Ridden Hunter. Open to horses over 15hns, qualifier cards will be spilt into small, lightweight, middleweight and heavyweight.

Class 7: Riding Club Horse/Pony. Ridden. Will be required to jump a small fence. Scoring Suitability 30% Performance and manners 30% Conformation 20% Overall presentation 20%. Qualifier cards will be spilt into junior and senior.

Each class is split into Lead Rein, Juniors and Seniors with rosettes awarded separately.

Working Hunter: To start approx 30 minutes after the last showing class. Entrance Fee : £3.50 per class Rosettes to 4th place

Class 1 Juniors - 2ft max.

Class 2 Seniors - 2ft max

Class 3 Juniors - 2ft 6" max

Class 4 Seniors - 2ft 6" max

Scoring : Jumping Phase 50% Style and manners whilst jumping 20% Style and manners whilst showing 10% Conformation 20%

Competitors entering both classes 1 & 3 or 2 & 4 may enter the latter class HC (for the jumping phase) only.

Ring Six

Barrel Jumping.

Start 2.00pm. Entrance Fee: £2.00

Rosettes to 4th place.

Class 1: Lead Rein

Class 2: Open

A chance for all to have a little jumping fun.

Starting at 5 barrels laid flat, keep your mount jumping straight and clean. 1 barrel being removed after each round until we are left with 1.

Cleanest, straightest jump wins!

Gymkhana

Start 2.30pm onwards Entrance Fee: £5.00 block entry.

Rosettes to 10th place overall Races will be decided on the day.

Lead Rein under 8 on 01/01/2011

A Group under 11 on 01/01/2011

B Group under 14 on 01/01/2011

C Group 14 and over on 01/01/2011

Gymkhana specific Rule and Regulations

1. Arms must be covered in Gymkhana
2. No whips, spurs or use of the rope as a whip allowed
3. The pony and runner must be nominated for the day and to last all day.
4. Lead rein in A, B or C Group must be non-competitive
5. If there are insufficient entries, the judge has the right to merge classes.
6. The judges decision is final.
7. The above are in addition to the General rules and regulations of Hartshill Riding Club.

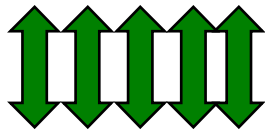

Class 1: In Hand Handler. It is the handler that is being judged. Qualifier cards will be spilt into junior and senior.

Class 2: In Hand Veteran. Open to horses/ponies over the age of 15 years old. Qualifier cards will be spilt into not exc 148 cm and over 148 cm.

Class 3: In Hand Mountain and Moorland. Open to all Native breeds, this will be spilt into small and large breeds. Qualifier cards will be spilt into small, large and Shetland and Welsh.

Class 4: In hand Hunter. Open to horses over 15hhs, qualifier cards will be spilt into small, lightweight, middleweight and heavyweight.

Class 5: In hand Coloured horse/pony. Qualifier cards will be spilt into Piebald/ Skewbald and Palomino/ Dun/ Cream/ Roan.

Class 6: Best Turned Out. Ridden Horse/Pony must be correctly and immaculately presented to the judge. Scoring: Overall view 40% Horse/ Pony 30% Rider 30% **Qualifier cards will be split into Plaited and Native.**

Class 7: Best Rider. Ridden. Scoring : Position of Rider 20% Correctness and effectiveness of aids 20% Individual show 30% Overall presentation 30%. This Qualifier cards will be spilt into Lead Rein, junior and senior.

Class 8: Mountain and Moorland. Ridden. Open to all Native breeds, will be spilt into small and large breeds. Qualifier cards will be spilt into small, large and Shetland and Welsh.

Full or Day membership is required.

Entrance fee £3.50 per class.
